1. God you want us to have NOW faith. (hour 2, September 23, 2020)

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. **Hebrews 11:1 NIV**

2. It's about the harvest...reach the cities! (hour 18, November 4, 2020)

Then they will make the teaching about God our Savior attractive in every way. For the grace of God has been revealed, bringing salvation to all people. **Titus 2:10b-11 NLT**

3. With God's help, we will do mighty things! (hour 28, November 13, 2020)

With God's help we will do mighty things... **Psalm 60:12a NLT**

4. Go to the Mountain of God! He will instruct all the people! (hour 49, December 12, 2020)

"But watch out! Be careful never to forget what you yourself have seen. Do not let these memories escape from your mind as long as you live! And be sure to pass them on to your children and grandchildren. Never forget the day when you stood before the Lord your God at Mount Sinai, where he told me, 'Summon the people before me, and I will personally instruct them. Then they will learn to fear me as long as they live, and they will teach their children to fear me also.' "You came near and stood at the foot of the mountain, while flames from the mountain shot into the sky. The mountain was shrouded in black clouds and deep darkness." **Deuteronomy 4:9-10 NLT**

5. Reach 1 million souls. Past, present and future. (hour 51, December 14, 2020)

So Israel conquered the entire area from Aroer at the edge of the Arnon Gorge all the way to Mount Sirion, also called Mount Hermon. **Deuteronomy 4:48 NLT**

Mt. Hermon means "Sacred Mountain" (sacred: holy, set apart for a specific purpose)

Six days later Jesus took Peter and the two brothers, James and John, and led them up a high mountain to be alone. As the men watched, Jesus' appearance was transformed so that his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as light. Suddenly, Moses and Elijah appeared and began talking with Jesus. Peter exclaimed, "Lord, it's wonderful for us to be here! If you want, I'll make three shelters as memorials—one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." But even as he spoke, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy. Listen to him." The disciples were

terrified and fell face down on the ground. **Matthew 17:1-6 NLT**
