1. Never say to God you have nothing to offer God when you do have something.

The wife of a man from the company of the prophets cried out to Elisha, “Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that he revered the Lord. But now his creditor is coming to take my two boys as his slaves.” Elisha replied to her, “How can I help you? Tell me, what do you have in your house?” “Your servant has nothing there at all,” she said, “except a small jar of olive oil.” **2 Kings 4:1-2 NIV**

2. Make a big ask of yourself.

Elisha said, “Go around and ask all your neighbors for empty jars. Don’t ask for just a few. Then go into your house with your sons and shut the door behind you. Pour olive oil from your flask into the jars, setting each one aside when it is filled.” **2 Kings 4:3-4 NIV**

3. The miracle of God in your life is only limited by your own faith.

So she did as she was told. Her sons kept bringing jars to her, and she filled one after another. Soon every container was full to the brim! “Bring me another jar,” she said to one of her sons. “There aren’t any more!” he told her. And then the olive oil stopped flowing. When she told the man of God what had happened, he said to her, “Now sell the olive oil and pay your debts, and you and your sons can live on what is left over.” **2 Kings 4:5-7 NLT**
