1. If you want to go higher in worship, it's gotta click for you. Do you realize what God has done for you?

You thrill me, LORD, with all you have done for me! I sing for joy because of what you have done. **Psalm 92:4 NLT**

“Arise, Jerusalem! Let your light shine for all to see. For the glory of the LORD rises to shine on you. Darkness...covers all the nations of the earth, but the glory of the LORD rises and appears over you.” **Isaiah 60:1-2 NLT**

2. To go higher, you must be bolted down (planted) with a good foundation.

3. Never make a decision during your dip!

But we all, with unveiled face beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are transformed into the same image from glory to glory, even as from the Lord the Spirit. **2 Corinthians 3:18 ASV**

I waited patiently for the LORD to help me, and he turned to me and heard my cry. He lifted me out of the pit of despair, out of the mud and the mire. He set my feet on solid ground and steadied me as I walked along. **Psalm 40:1-2 NLT**

4. During your dips, lift your hands up and trust the Creator.

I lift my hands to you in prayer...Come quickly, LORD, and answer me, for my depression deepens. Don't turn away from me...for I am trusting you...Show me where to walk, for I give myself to you. **Psalm 143:6-7, 8b NLT**

5. Quit stepping through! Give your life to Jesus.

If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. **Romans 10:9 NAS**
