You know that under pressure, your faith-life is forced into the open and shows its true colors. **James 1:3 MSG**

So don't try to get out of anything prematurely. Let it do its work so you become mature and well-developed, not deficient in any way. **James 1:4 MSG**

We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in

despair; Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed; **2 Corinthians 4:8-9 KJV**

The joy of the Lord is your strength. **Nehemiah 8:10b KJV**

But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; Let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them; Let those also who love Your name Be joyful in You. **Psalms 5:11 NKJV**

For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance. **Hebrews 10:34 KJV**
