**Our Mission: To take as many people to Heaven as we can before we die. Period.**

### **1. We have fallen for lies.**

"...there is no truth in [the Devil]. Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own nature, for he is a liar and the father of lies." **John 8:44b NAS**

### **2. Apply the truth to your lie.**

Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil. For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places. ## **FIRST THREE LIES**

### **Lie #1: I'm not important.**

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life." **John 3:16 ESV**
