The Harvest Principle: You will reap what you sow.

The best predictor of your future is to ask, "What am I sowing now?"

"Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life." **Galatians 6:8 NIV**

What do you do if you find yourself in a bad harvest?

1. You have to take responsibility for the seed you sowed.
2. You have to repent and ask God to forgive you.
3. Look for God to bring good out of a bad harvest.

"And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose." **Romans 8:28 NIV**

Do you want to create a predictable harvest?

Practice selective seed sowing.

Before sowing a decision into our lives pray and ask Jesus:

- Will this seed produce a desirable harvest in my life?
- Will it move me closer or farther away from God?
- Will it strengthen or weaken my marriage?
- Will it move me towards my goals or take me off track?

It's never too late to begin sowing good seed.

"Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up." **Galatians 6:9 NIV**
