

The Unstoppable People of God

1. We want a strategy; God gives Us a waiting room.

Once when he was eating with them, he commanded them, “Do not leave Jerusalem until the Father sends you the gift he promised, as I told you before. John baptized with water, but in just a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” **Acts 1:4-5 NLT**

2. Every unstoppable move of God starts on stopped knees.

They all met together and were constantly united in prayer, along with Mary the mother of Jesus, several other women, and the brothers of Jesus. **Acts 1:14 NLT**

These all devoted themselves single-mindedly to prayer. **Acts 1:14 CJB**

God’s plans involve two things:

Eternity impacting.

You are the light of the world...let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.” **Matthew 5:14-16 NIV**

3. You can’t skip the waiting room to get to the reach.

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” **Acts 1:8^{NLT}**

Then the apostles returned to Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives, a distance of half a mile. When they arrived, they went to the upstairs room of the house where they were staying.
